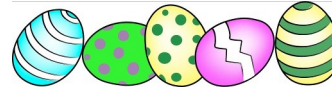

Once the kids began to read the story from the Megillah of Esther we sounded those graggers at every mention of Haman's name.

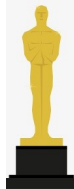
We all agreed it was nice learning a new tradition even if it wasn't our own.

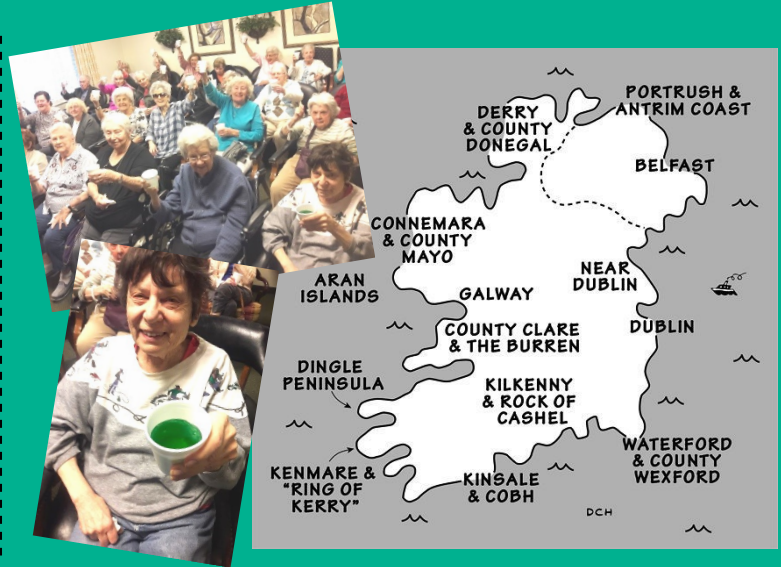
