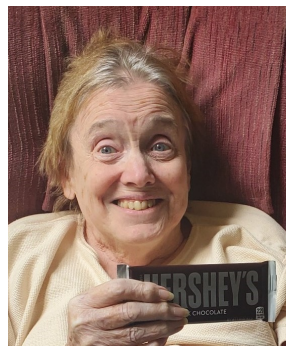

With summer just around the corner we asked a few of our residents what their favorite summer activity is? We here are the Arbors are certainly ready for the summer! Bring on the warm weather!

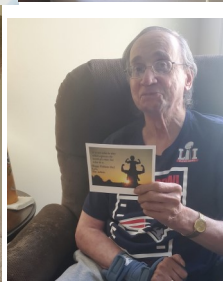
